

ORDINANCE #2 69-1 H.M.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LITTERING  
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF ONEKAMA  
MANISTEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN.

THE TOWNSHIP OF ONEKAMA ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That no person or persons shall scatter, leave or distribute any bottles, containers or other refuse on the street, alleys, sidewalks or roadways of the Township of Onkama, Manistee County, Michigan, or on private property within the limits of said Township.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof by any Court of competent jurisdiction, be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than Ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance being an emergency Ordinance necessary to protect the health, welfare and public safety of the citizens of the Township of Onkama, it is Ordered to take immediate effect upon publication thereof as provided by law.
